READING

- ▶ Instead of reading records, Year 5 and 6 will be monitored through their word count on Accelerated Reader. The pupils will take books from the library bus and will then take quizzes to test their understanding of the book.
- ▶ Accelerated Reader will be used across the school, where classes will compete against one another to achieve the highest word count collectively.
- ▶ Please encourage your child to read at home at least **four** times a week and continue to help them develop their reading, with a focus on comprehension.

HOMework

- We will be introducing 'Homework Bingo' into UKS2. The children will be able to take greater ownership over their homework and can select the topic-based activities that they would like to complete. The children should complete three activities in a row to get bingo. Alternatively, they could even try and get a full house. **Week beginning 21st October 2019**, we will be looking at the work the children have completed.
- After Christmas, Year 6 children complete CGP booklets to help them prepare for their SATs.



SPaG

- SPaG stands for Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar. It is a core focus of the English National Curriculum released in 2014.
- There will be three explicit SPaG sessions per week. In these focussed sessions, the children are taught specific spelling patterns.
- It will be an expectation for Y5/6 to practise their spellings at home. Year 5 and 6 will take home three of the Y5/6 spelling words and will be tested on a selection of these at the end of each term.
